Overall purpose of the post

Main responsibilities and duties

- 1. To undertake and assist in the provision of excellent standards of garden maintenance and presentation at all times generally through:
 - Formative, seasonal and rejuvative pruning of deciduous and evergreen trees, shrubs, climbers and hedges.



- Safe and careful use of garden machinery as necessary including mowers, strimmers, tractor and trailers, shredders, scarifiers, snow ploughs and other machinery and hired plant.
- Machine maintenance.
- Specialist turf maintenance.
- The appropriate, timely and safe use of pesticides, as directed.
- Optimum use of composting systems.
- Maintenance of paths, gates and other hard landscaping.
- 2. To take on specific areas of responsibility within the garden, undertaking the practical maintenance of these areas, according to a programme of works set out by the Senior Gardener.
- 3. To develop an understanding of the garden's history and plant collections.
